Question: What is the difference between the Member PCP ID field (ME046) and the Attributed PCP Provider ID field (ME124) in the Member Eligibility file?



<u>Answer</u>: For ME046 (**Member PCP ID**) carriers report the PCP identifier for their members with a corresponding ID in the Provider File. ME046 is *only used for members whose insurance <u>products require</u> the selection of a primary care physician (e.g. health maintenance organizations or point of service plans).*

For ME124 (Attributed PCP Provider ID) carriers report PCPs attributed to the members whose insurance <u>products do not require</u> the selection of a primary care physician (e.g. preferred provider organization plans or indemnity products). This attribution is **based on the carrier's own attribution methodology**. This value is reported in December only, for the year prior to the current year. For example: the December 2013 file reports the Attributed PCP for 2012 for members enrolled in 2012.
