MA APCD CY 2024: De-Identification Summary

Introduction

The Center for Health Information and Analysis (CHIA)'s enabling statute (M.G.L. Ch 12C¹) permits the disclosure of data from the commercial payers, third-party administrators, and public programs included in the Massachusetts All-Payer Claims Database (MA APCD). While CHIA is not a covered entity under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA), HIPAA provides requirements for the de-identification of heath information.

To make the most robust set of health care data available to the widest audience, CHIA contracted with Onpoint Health Data to assist in the creation of an expert de-identified version of the MA APCD (as defined by the HIPAA Privacy Rule²). This document outlines the de-identification pathways defined in the HIPAA Privacy Rule and summarizes all the data masking, generalizations, and transformations required to produce a de-identified version of the MA APCD.

De-Identification Concepts and Methods

The HIPAA Privacy Rule is intended to safeguard identifiable health information by allowing only specific uses and disclosures. Recognizing the value of health data even when it does not identify individuals, the Rule permits the creation and disclosure of **de-identified data** that adhere to certain de-identification standards and implementation guidelines.

To achieve de-identification, the Privacy Rule accepts two different methods:

- 1. Expert Determination: A qualified expert applies statistical principles to determine that the risk of re-identifying an individual is very small.
- 2. Safe Harbor: The disclosing entity removes specific identifiers and certifies that it has no knowledge that the remaining data could be used to identify someone, either in isolation or when combined with other information.

The Safe Harbor method of deidentification requires the removal of 18 categories of identifiers. Removed identifiers include names, addresses, five-digit ZIP codes, birth dates, admission dates, discharge dates, and dates of service). Removal of these key data elements often makes the resulting data less useful in research, quality improvement and public health analysis.

De-Identification in the MA APCD

To make the most robust set of health care data readily available to the widest audience, CHIA and Onpoint employed the Expert Determination method.

There are several differences between CHIA's Expert Determination De-Identification and HIPAA Safe Harbor. Firstly, the CHIA model is less restrictive than Safe Harbor with respect to:

- certain ZIP Codes in Massachusetts, which are reported at the 5-digit level (or as an amalgamation of multiple 5-digit ZIP Codes)
- admission date, discharge date, and date of service
- birth month/year

Secondly, the CHIA model is more restrictive with respect to individual geographic and demographic details, as well as on certain codes corresponding to notable publicly recognizable or reportable events. The following types of information are removed:

- diagnosis codes indicating birth, death, trauma-related events, or public emergencies
- marital status
- family size
- student status
- race
- ethnicity
- ZIP Codes for states outside of Massachusetts
- U.S. state codes outside of New England and New York

Additionally, the CHIA model generalizes certain terms to mitigate re-identification risks:

- language spoken, which is limited to English, Spanish, and Other
- gender

Finally, the CHIA model applies risk mitigation strategies that are not required by Safe Harbor:

Recipients of CHIA's de-identified data must sign a Data Use Agreement.³
